- ✓ 259 respondents
- ✓ Q2: Main reasons respondents participate in the JK & British Championships:
  - ✓ Good terrain, Good quality mapping, Multiple days of orienteering
- ✓ Q3: Main reasons for participating in the UKOL:
  - ✓ Good quality mapping, Variety of terrain types
- ✓ Q4: What year did you last participate in the JK & British Championships:
  - ✓ 31 respondents
  - ✓ JK-7 last took part in 2010, 10 said it was that long ago they couldn't remember
  - ✓ British Champs-7 last took part in 2014, 13 said it was that long ago they couldn't remember

- ✓ Q5: Main reasons for not participating in JK, British Champs or UKOL in 2015:
  - ✓ Too far to travel/travel costs, Prefer to support local level C & D events, Entry costs too high
- ✓ Q6: What would encourage you to participate in the JK, British Champs or UKOL events in 2016
  - ✓ Quality of the event-terrain, good planning, good mapping
  - ✓ Keeping entry fees low
  - ✓ Multiple days in close proximity
  - ✓ Level of competition in age class
  - ✓ Proximity to home
