

## Report on BOF Internal Communications

At the Council meeting on 21<sup>st</sup> January, a report titled BOF Internal Communications was received from Keith Auchterlonie, Keith having been commissioned in July 2005 to 'ascertain the views of the orienteering community about how communications between them and 'BOF' should work'.

To quote from the report, 'A study was carried out, with questionnaires being sent to all individual members and to club secretaries. The views of associations, BOF officers and selected individuals were sought by Email, telephone and face to face meetings'. The findings are summarised in a very readable 4 page Executive Summary and in the very detailed full report (95 pages). In all, there are 15 recommendations.

Council decided to seek opinions on the priorities with association representatives reporting on the views from their areas. Mike Hamilton, Chief Executive, was asked to report back on staff views and on the practicalities of cost and time implications. The next Council meeting on 6 May will then discuss and approve the implementation plan.
