

Formation of supporting workgroups

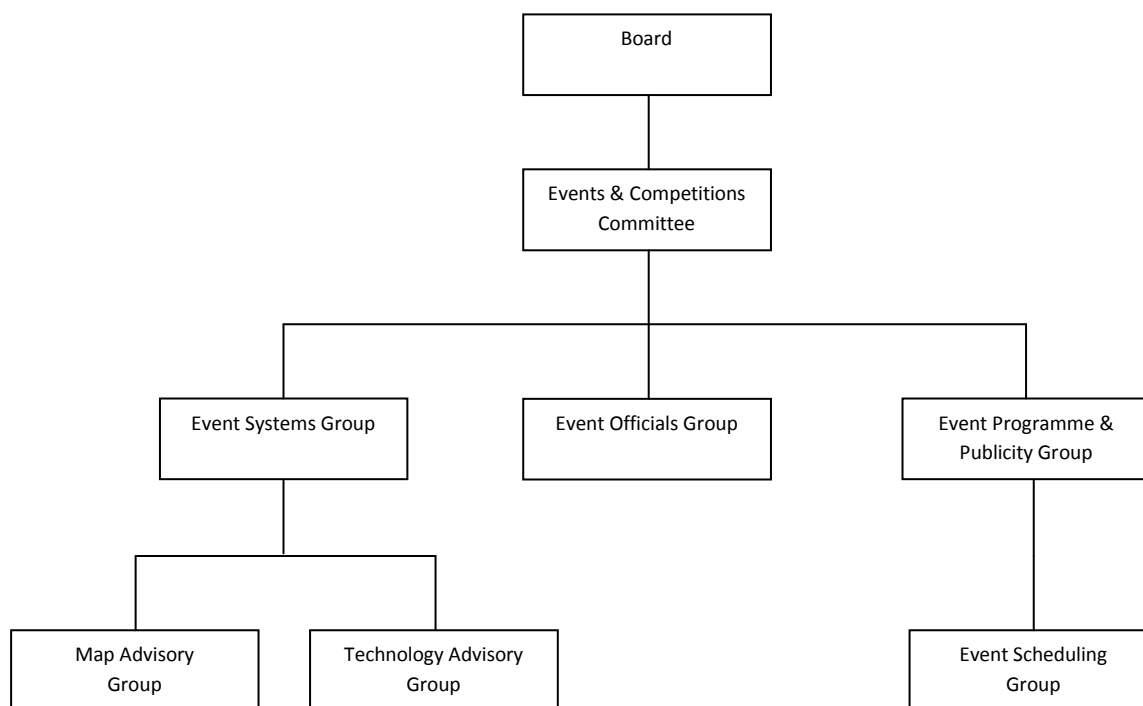
Events & Competitions Committee has been set up with authority delegated by the Board as follows:

“To co-ordinate, oversee and monitor orienteering events and competitions; the Committee will ensure that events and competition structures are aligned with the vision, values and strategic objectives as determined by the Board.”

In order to be able to carry out its many and varied responsibilities the Committee has decided to set up three workgroups to assist it in delivering various aspects of its workload. These are:

- Event Programme and Publicity Group
- Event Officials Group
- Event Systems Group

There will also be three specialist groups attached to the workgroups to support their work, as per the diagram below:



In addition to these workgroups and specialist groups, there will be a network of focus groups. These will be electronic, virtual groups only. They will be set up to try and ensure that there is as wide as possible consultation and information exchange on specific matters relating to the work of the Events and Competitions Committee. Focus groups will be set up once the workgroups and specialist groups are established.

Invitations are now sought from individuals who are willing to join one of the workgroups or specialist groups. An application forms and the terms of reference for each group are available from the British Orienteering website.
