Sites of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI)

NE say: "Make the earliest possible contact with the relevant NE office to advise them of sites under consideration and timing". On SSSIs events must not proceed without the consent of NE (or CCW in Wales), accordingly it is essential that local organisers find out whether such consent is likely to be achievable before making detailed preparations.
