

## Major Events Survey 2015

- Carried out after all the partnership Events
- 259 respondents
- Q2: Main reasons respondents participate in the JK & British Championships:
  - Good terrain, Good quality mapping, Multiple days of orienteering
- ✓ Q3: Main reasons for participating in the UKOL:
  - ✓ Good quality mapping, Variety of terrain types
- Q4: What year did you last participate in the JK & British Championships:
  - √ 31 respondents
  - JK-7 last took part in 2010, 10 said it was that long ago they couldn't remember
  - British Champs-7 last took part in 2014, 13 said it was that long ago they couldn't remember



- Q5: Main reasons for not participating in JK, British Champs or UKOL in 2015:
  - Too far to travel/travel costs, Prefer to support local level C & D events, Entry costs too high
- Q6: What would encourage you to participate in the JK, British Champs or UKOL events in 2016
  - Quality of the event-terrain, good planning, good mapping
  - Keeping entry fees low
  - Multiple days in close proximity
  - Level of competition in age class
  - Proximity to home
