

Streetspace Orienteering Challenge competition

Terms and conditions

The Promoters of the **Streetspace Orienteering Challenge** competition (“the Competition”) is Transport for London, 5 Endeavour Square, London E20 1JN and British Orienteering, Scholes Mill, Old Coach Road, Tansley, Matlock, DE4 5FY. Entry is only open to UK residents aged 18 or over excluding employees of Transport for London and British Orienteering, or any of their subsidiaries advisers, agents and/or anyone connected with the organisation of this promotion.

If you are using your work computer you may need to obtain your employer’s permission prior to entering.

The Competition begins on 16 September 2020 at 00:00 (“the Opening Date”) and ends on 31 October 2020 at 23:59 (“the Closing Date”). Entries to the Competition must be submitted before the Closing Date.

In order to enter the Competition, you must complete and submit your answers via the Competition online form link.

To submit an entry, you must visit https://www.britishorienteering.org.uk/streetspace_challenges and complete the online form. Any entry which is incomplete or submitted through an alternative method will be rejected.

Transport for London is not be responsible for late, lost or delayed entries or network, computer hardware or software failures of any kind that may delay or restrict entry into the competition.

There are five different courses available in the Competition. Only one entry per person. Completion of different courses from the same person will count towards one entry.

Eight winners will receive prizes.

There are eight prizes. Each prize is a Moquette Picnic Bag with Mat from London Transport Museum. One person can only win a maximum of one prize regardless of their number of entries.

The winners will be the entrants who in the sole opinion of the judges submits the correctly completed forms to the Competition.

By submitting an entry to the Competition, you give Transport for London permission for your entry to be used Transport for London and you grant Transport for London a non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide licence to use and publish your entry.

The winners will be notified by 9 November 2020 and must respond within 48 hours otherwise another winner or winners will be picked.

The winners will be required to collect the prizes at London Transport Museum, Covent Garden Piazza, London WC2E 7BB within 30 days of the Closing Date. Travel is not included.

The winners will need to be able to provide proof of identity and age to collect the prizes.

The names of winners will be made available if requested by 9 November 2020.

Winners may be invited to take part in promotional activities.

The judges' decision is final and binding in all matters and no correspondence will be entertained.

The Promoters reserve the right to substitute any prizes with a prize of equivalent or higher value in the event of circumstances outside of its control. There is no cash alternative to prizes.

Entry into the Competition implies acceptance of these terms and conditions. Transport for London reserves the right to refuse to award prizes to anyone found to be in breach of these terms and conditions.
