¹ Significant extensions should be at least an additional 20% of the original map area, Major revisions should be where the map has been redrawn and/or the update is of a map over 5 years old. Minor additions and map corrections are not eligible unless these are by the original mapper of a map not submitted in previous years.

² Professional mappers are those earning more than £6,000 per annum from orienteering mapping.

³ For example, novice, junior mappers, use of technology and similar.
