

## TEACHING ORIENTERING COURSES

### NEW TUTOR QUALIFICATION PATHWAYS



#### Qualification Pathway for Teaching Orienteering Tutors

1. Must have a recognized teaching qualification OR a Certificate in Tutoring in Sport (CTS) OR Preparing to Teach in the Lifelong Learning Sector (PTLLS)
2. Must have at least either UKCC Level 1 in Orienteering OR 'old' Level 1 Coaching Course
3. Must indicate to British Orienteering interest in becoming a Teaching Orienteering tutor either by email [info@britishorienteering.org.uk](mailto:info@britishorienteering.org.uk) or by phone 01629 734042
4. Must pay the fee for a Teaching Orienteering Pack (cost £110)
5. Must attend and observe a Teaching Orienteering Course (1 day)
6. British Orienteering will assign an accredited \*observer to the prospective tutor and they are asked to make contact with them. \*An observer is someone who is IAPS assessor qualified and is an existing Teaching Orienteering Tutor
7. Prospective tutor is asked to complete a course registration form (NEW TUTORS) which includes an additional box where the name of the observer is included. The Prospective Tutor is given resources to run a course. The observer mentors the prospective tutor through the course booking administration procedure (up to delivery day) and should be copied into the correspondence.
8. The prospective tutor then organises and delivers a course (as they would normally) and this is then observed by the observer.
9. The observer uses the observation checklist throughout the delivery and signs off the prospective tutor at the end of a satisfactory delivery. There is the option of an action plan coming out of the observation checklist which the prospective tutor should take note off. If an action plan is included the observer will have a professional discussion with the prospective tutor once the actions are completed. After this point the observer can sign off the tutor.
10. Upon successful completion the tutor is added to the list of available Teaching Orienteering tutors.
