

WOC 2015 Embargoed terrain.

The areas, marked in red on the following maps, contain terrain to be used as part of British Orienteering's bid to stage WOC2015 and therefore are embargoed.

Competitors, team officials and other persons, who, through the knowledge of the terrain, may influence the results of the competitions, are not allowed to enter the embargoed areas.

Public roads are open for passage through terrain.

For Inverness, Forres and Elgin embargoed areas:

- It is allowed: to stay, to live, to shop, and to work as a resident, a student, a worker or as a tourist.

- It is prohibited: to orienteer through the city, to test route choices, and to enter into the wooded areas.
